

# Ukraine's experience in developing the qualification system

- Law of Ukraine «On Education (2017)
- Order of Cabinet of Ministries on the National Qualification Framework
- Regulations re development of occupational standards, qualification centers accreditation, awarding of professional qualifications by qualification centers and so on
- Changes in legislation on qualifications (2022) clear link to occupational standards

# Universities and their role in qualification systems: (non)rhetorical questions


- Do Universities have responsibilities for profession to train qualified specialists?
