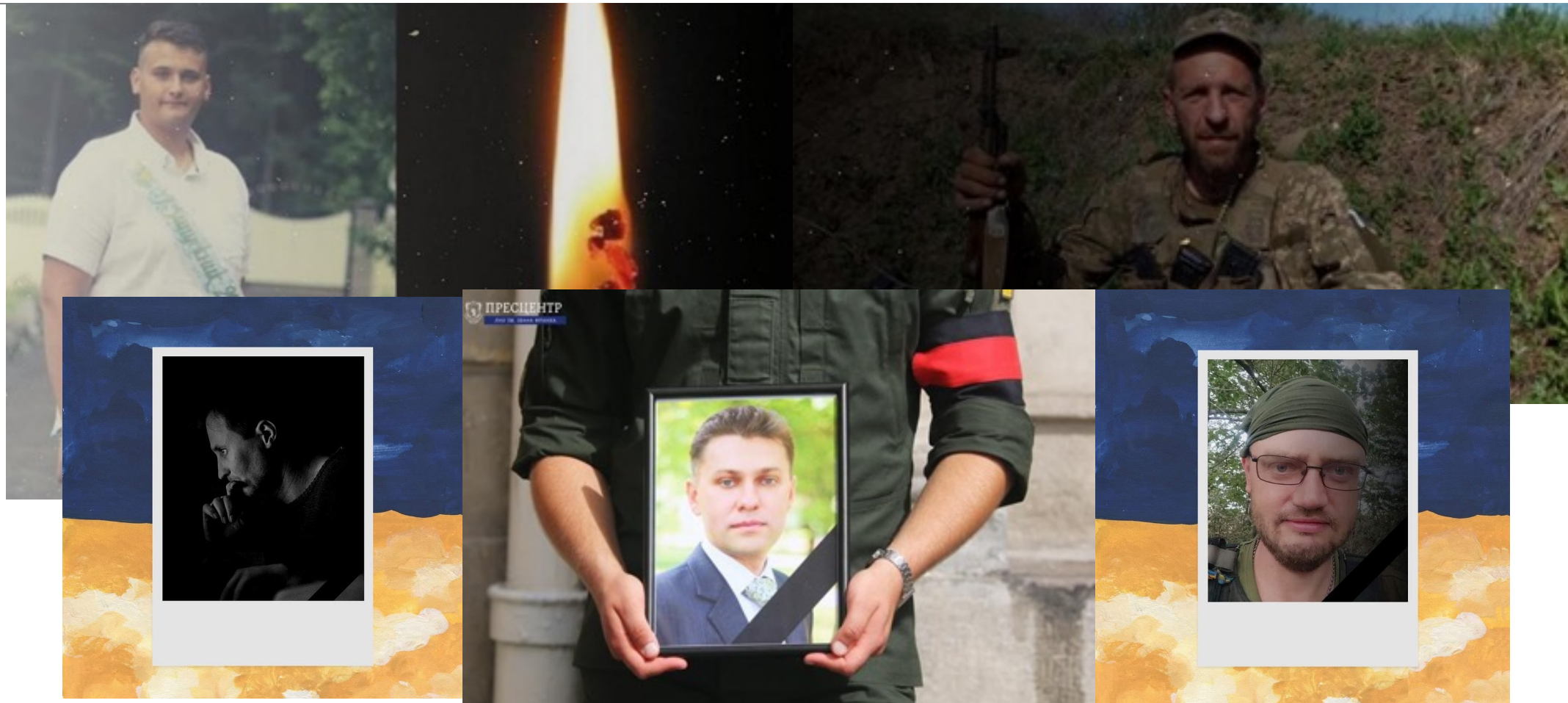

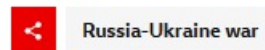

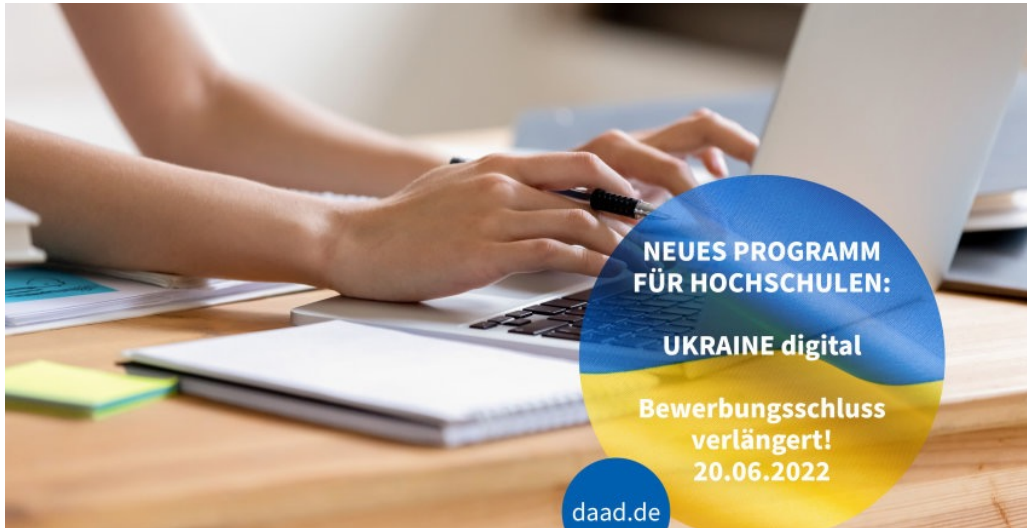

IFNUL Student Activities Priorities 2023

Volunteering:
