
UNIGE: PAST AND PRESENT

- □ 28 Ph.D. courses and 80 postgraduate courses



- •society, by creating prevention and screening campaigns



UniGe for cultural heritage and activities


UniGe is located in <u>prestigious buildings</u> of <u>historical and</u> artistic value.

There will be openings to the public and guided tours, particularly during the Rolli Days. The Botanical Garden in Genova and the Hanbury Botanical Gardens in Ventimiglia are also open to the public. The museums of Chemistry, Physics, Biology and the National Museum of Antarctica refer to the School of Mathematical, Physical and Natural Sciences.

The <u>EthnoMedicine Musueum</u> has a unique collection - and not only in the European museum scene - of more than 2000 objects (instruments, remedies, texts apparatuses, etc.) from over 100 human groups, related to the different medical traditions of the world. It's home to the UNESCO Chair of Anthropology of Health


UniGe social media


