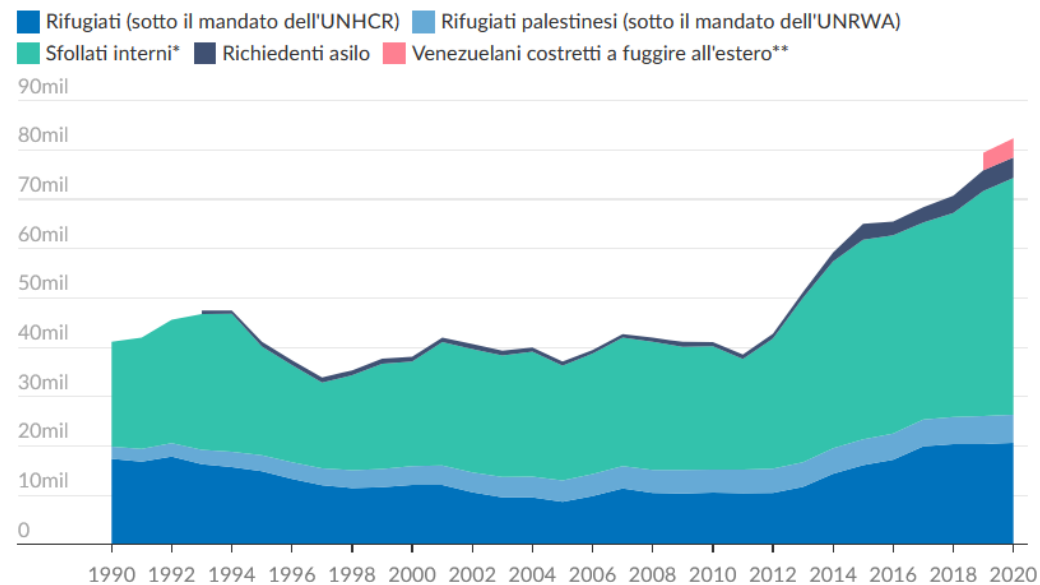

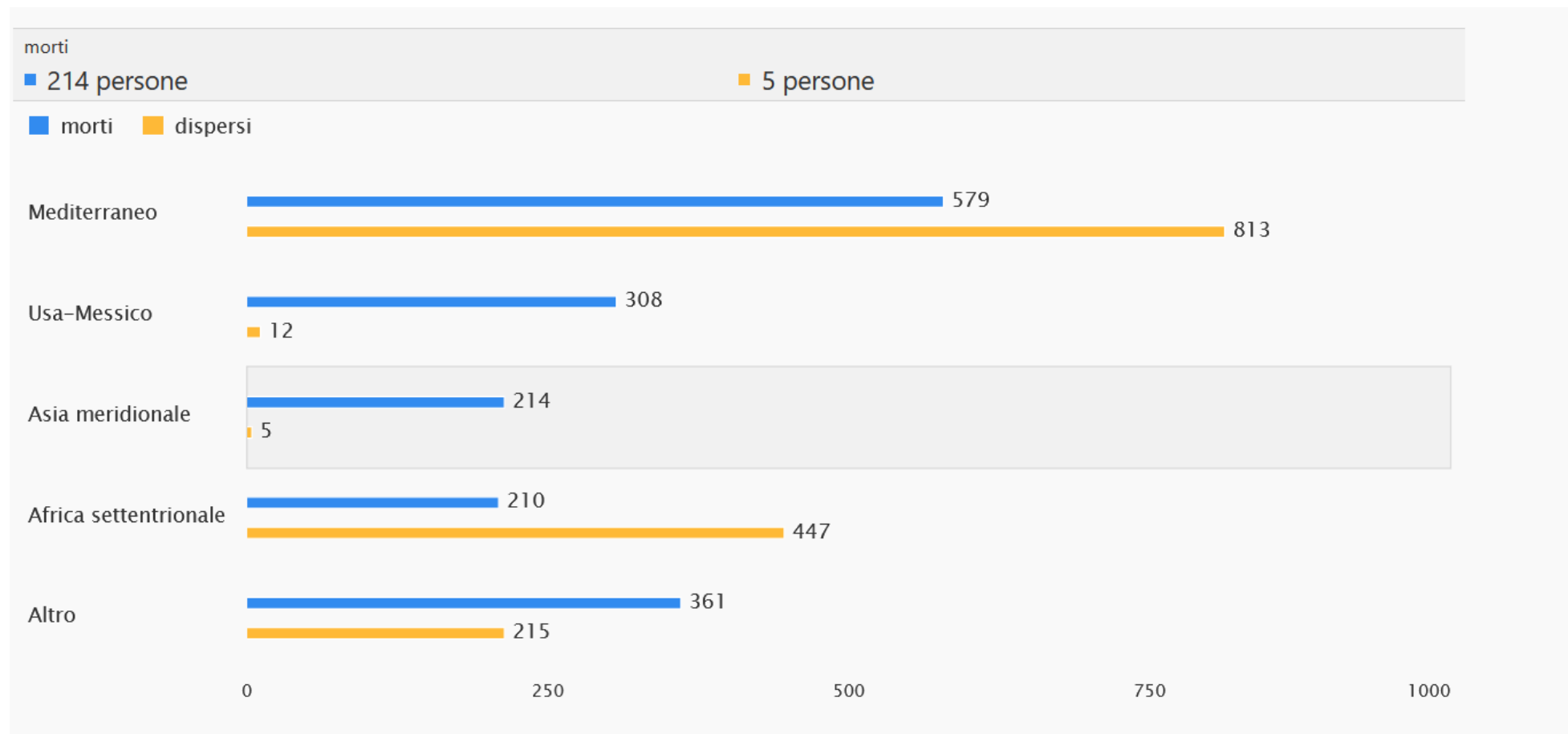

- For many years, the central Mediterranean route, which connects Libya and Tunisia to Italy, has been the main route of migration to Europe. Facing this dangerous route are often children without accompanying adult family members. It is estimated that more than 70,000 underage refugees and migrants have arrived in our country since 2014. Of many of them, defined in the statistics as 'untraceable', traces are lost because they are on the move to northern European countries, or because they are driven by a pressing economic need to leave the reception system.

- Approximately two-thirds of all unaccompanied minor applicants were between 16 and 17 years old, and girls accounted for only 6 per cent. It is estimated that more than 70,000 refugee and migrant minors have arrived in Italy since 2014.

# Figures

- **20,032** unaccompanied foreign minors in our country as of 30 November 2022.

An increase of **79.5%** compared to the same period in 2021.

**25.3%** are Ukrainian children and youth, reflecting the impact of the war on minors' lives.

**71%** were Ukrainian refugee children and youth enrolled in schools in our country last May.

School plays a central role as an engine of inclusion.
