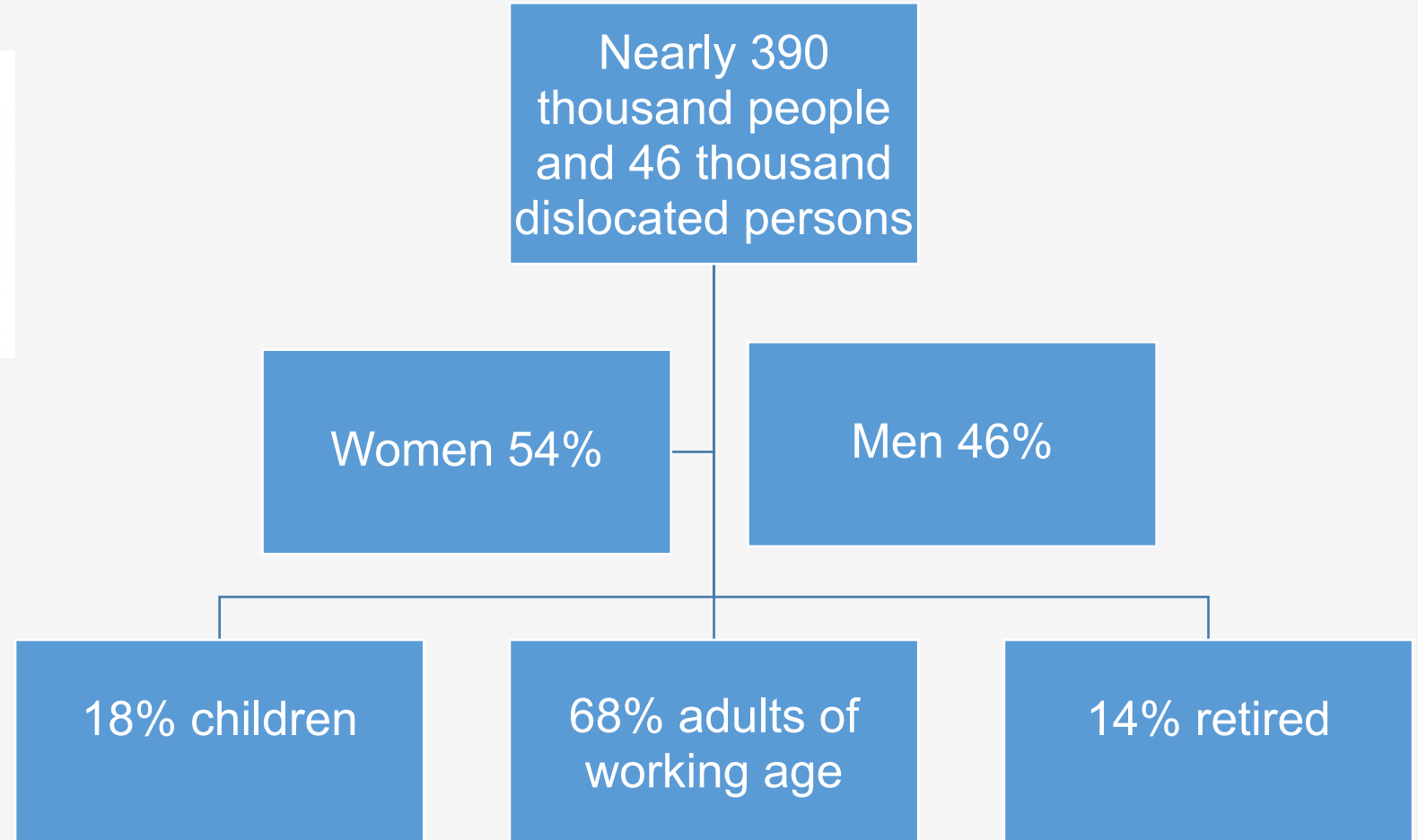

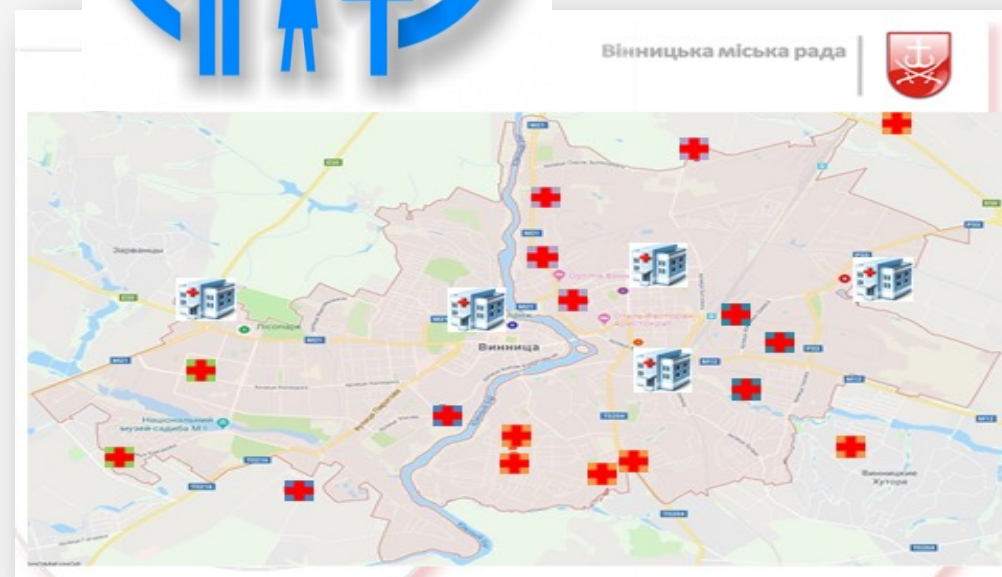

# Areas of Cooperation of the Municipal Healthcare System with the National Pirogov Memorial Medical University, Vinnytsya:

- ✓ Clinical departments located in municipal hospitals (scientific experience of diagnosis and treatment, medical teams)
- ✓ Expansion of types and amount of medical care
- ✓ Establishment of 3-way international cooperation (university-municipality-foreign partners)
- ✓ Providing with qualified personnel – graduates
- ✓ Improving the qualification of medical personnel - postgraduate education
- ✓ Cooperation with the Department of Healthcare
- ✓ Engagement into providing of medical assistance to wounded military and civilians
- ✓ Representatives of medical university departments take part in medical councils both at the level of hospitals and at the level of a local self-government body - under the mayor's office
- ✓ During the COVID pandemic, the team of the Department of Infectious Diseases participated in the development of a medical aid protocol and provided treatment to patients.
