Support Offered:





WHAT IS MENTORING?

- One-to-one team consultation with experts in different fields, entrepreneurs;
- A mentor from a specific sector may be involved;
- Either the mentor chooses the team or the team chooses the mentor;
- One-off consultation or repeated (over a longer period);
- Benefits for the team: different perspective, answers to questions, new contacts, action (next steps).


